Which specific tracks do you offer?

Our tracks will be divided into two sets with different skill levels: Mixed Tracks and Advanced Tracks. Within each set, various tracks will be offered. Please visit our website for further information concerning the specific track offers.

Mixed Tracks:

The Mixed Tracks will not focus on actual app developing as much as advanced tracks do. However, developers are needed here as well. Business students and students of other subjects will join Mixed Tracks with designers & developers.

Advanced Tracks:

The Advanced Tracks will be open especially for developers and designers because real developing and programming skills are needed for the tasks in this tracks.

Choosing your track

You can directly choose your track on a first come, first serve basis on the website. All tracks will have limited capacity. Nevertheless, we try our best to get you into your preferred track.

How does teambuilding work?

Teams should consist of 3 to 4 members. By Friday evening, teams have been formed and you will be directed to your specific track rooms. Please make sure form a team with the right mixture of skills from each member of the team! If you want to be in a team with your friends, make sure to pick the same tracks as long as available.

Workshops

The track sponsors will hold a workshop to tell you more about the tasks and goals of your track.

You will be able to get a first idea of app development from our participant booklet and you will learn a lot from team members that have skills in different areas than you.
